# Children's Talent Fest 2018

Dear Children's Director,

It is that time again to start preparing for the Children's TalentFest. The date is Saturday, February 24th, 2018 at StL Gateway Church of the Nazarene. Registration and check-in will start at 9:30 a.m. and the opening session begins at 10 a.m. Judging will begin promptly at 10:30 a.m. There will be a one hour lunch break. Feel free to bring a lunch or there are several restaurants nearby for your convenience. The fee for the event is \$4 per individual per category and \$10 per choir/large ensemble (large ensemble is a group of 6 or more). The entrance fees MUST be mailed in advance of the event to the address below and checks should be made out to the district. This year, we will be making online registration available and I HIGHLY encourage you to register online, but we will still accept paper registrations as well. Each child can register online themselves or turn in their paper copies to the children's director and you can register for them. The benefit of registering online is that you will be able to make any changes/additions to your entry up through February 16th. All entries must be received (either electronically or through the mail) by Friday, February 16th. This ensures that we have adequate time to have certificates printed for each entry.

I know TalentFest is an event that a lot of kids look forward to and enjoy being able to participate in every year. I hope you will encourage all your kids, preschool through sixth grade, to think about the areas in which they may be talented and to explore and use all the talents that God has blessed them with. This event is not just for those that are talented in music, art, or drama. The past few years have brought many changes to the talent festival including the inclusion of some new categories. One area that we are adding this year is the "technology" category. Children are invited to create and submit IN ADVANCE powerpoints, videos, web pages, etc. At TalentFest, the children are judged according to their own performance and not in competition with another child. A set of qualified judges in each category will look at each students' talent and score them on a scale of 1-4 (with 1 being the best) in different areas that pertain to that particular category. There will be different scoring sheets used for the different age categories, which are listed on the following page. This is being done so that the criteria the children are being judged on is age appropriate. Please also note that one of the areas that each talent will be judged on is "compliance to rules." Some of the expectations/rules have changed this year so please make sure that all kids (and their parents) know what the rules or guidelines are for each category to avoid being marked down in this area. Please send only one packet of paper applications with one check per church. Checks may be made out to "Missouri District Church of the Nazarene" with "Children's Talent" written on the memo line. #### Age Categories

Preschool - Ages 4-5
Primary - Kindergarten through 3rd grade
Intermediate - 4th through 6th grade

NOTE: Each child may have as many as two separate entries in any category but no more than 3 total entries for the day. Groups of two or more will be placed in the age category of the oldest child in the group.

## Talent Categories and Rules

#### VOCAL MUSIC

This category will consist of vocal solos, duets, trios, quartets, and choirs.

#### RULES FOR VOCAL MUSIC:

- 1. Selection must be no longer than 4 minutes.
- 2. Two copies of the music must be submitted to the judges before the performance; one must be original.

### Please no handwritten lyrics.

- 3. Selection must be Christian, patriotic, or classical.
  - 4. Selection must be memorized.
- 5. Performance will be judged on pitch/harmony, tone quality, rhythm, dynamics, diction, effect, stage presence, and technical difficulty.

#### DRAMATIC ARTS

This category will include puppetry, monologues, skits,, ventriloquist acts, and teaching of a Sunday School lesson.

#### RULES FOR DRAMATIC ARTS:

- 1. Selection must be no longer than 8 minutes.
- 2. Two copies must be submitted to the judges before performance; one must be original. Please no

# handwritten entries.

- 3. Selection must be Christian or patriotic.
  - 4. Selection must be memorized.
- Performance will be judged on expression, diction, effect, stage presence, and technical difficulty.

#### INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC

This category will consist of instrumental solos, duets, trios, quartets, and choirs.

#### RULES FOR INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC:

- 1. Selection must be no longer than 4 minutes.
- 2. Two copies of the music must be submitted to the judges before performance; one must be original.
- 3. Selection must be Christian, patriotic, or classical.
  - 4. Selection does NOT need to be memorized.
- Performance will be judged on pitch/harmony, tone quality, dynamics, articulation, effect, stage presence, and technical difficulty.

#### VISUAL ARTS

This category will include photography, needlework, drawings, paintings, and three-dimensional projects and coloring (preschool category only).

#### RULES FOR VISUAL ARTS:

- 1. Theme and name of child card must be adjacent to the projects. Cards will be given out at registration.
- 2. Entry must have a Christian, nature, or patriotic theme.
- Entry will be judged on line, shape, form, color, value, texture, space, balance, design, creativity, technique, and neatness.

### **Talent Categories and Rules Continued**

#### **CULINARY ARTS**

This category will include cooking appetizers, main dishes, vegetables, desserts and other dishes.

#### **RULES FOR CULINARY ARTS:**

- 1. Name of dish and child card must be adjacent to the dish. Cards will be given out at registration.
- 2. Dishes must be prepared prior to talent event. A microwave/oven will be available for reheating.
- 3. Dishes will be judged on presentation, creativity and taste.
- 4. All entry's MUST have a display showing each step of your culinary project. (example take pictures while making your culinary project, show recipe etc...) Please no handwritten recipes.

#### BIBLE MEMORIZATION

This category will include reciting a memorized Bible verse.

#### RULES FOR BIBLE MEMORIZATION:

- 1. Preschool must have at least 1 verse memorized.
  Primary must have at least 5 verses memorized.
  Intermediate must have at least 10 verses memorized.
- 2. Two copies of the full passage must be submitted to the judges before recitation.
- 3. Recitation will be judged on memorization, expression, diction, stage presence, and difficulty.

#### CREATIVE WRITING

This category will consist of short stories and essays.

#### RULES FOR CREATIVE WRITING:

- 1. Primary must have at least ½ page typed. Intermediate must have at least 1 page typed.
- 2. Writing will be judged on ideas and content, word choice, conventions, organization, and sentence fluency.
  - 3. Entries must be submitted in advance with the application by February 16th, 2018! (if registering online, writing can be submitted through e-mail)

#### TECHNOLOGY

Any entry in this category must be submitted electronically in advance.

#### RULES FOR TECHNOLOGY:

- 1. Must be Christian or patriotic/nature.
- 2. If a video is submitted, length can be no longer than 3 minutes.
- 3. All entries may be submitted separately from the registration, but must be received electronically by the deadline date of February 16th.

### GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR 2018 MISSOURI DISTRICT TALENT FESTIVAL

- 1. Child must attend a Missouri District Nazarene Church.
- 2. Child may enter up to 3 total events.
- 2. All registrations and fees must be received by the deadline (February 16th, 2018).
- 3. For music entries, piano or CD accompaniment may be used. The use of accompaniment CDs with or without background vocals will be permitted. Please no cassette tapes as we do not have the technology to play them.
- 4. If a child has sent an application but is no longer able to attend, please notify the TalentFest director as soon as possible.
- 5. Children with entries in all categories must be checked in at the talent site by 10:30 a.m.
- 6. Creative writing entries must be submitted with talent application by February 16th, 2018.
- 7. All judges were selected based on their expertise in their judged category and their decisions are final.
