

DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT TRANSITION

The District Advisory Committee (DAC) has begun its search process for the next District Superintendent (DS) for the MO District. In this document you will find information intended to keep you well-informed and connected throughout this process, including a Call to Prayer, a District Survey & Assessment, Zone Zoom Meetings, the Timeline, and FAQ.

A CALL TO PRAYER

Believing in the importance and power of prayer, we would like to call the district family to prayer. Our theme verse during this transitional period is:

Jeremiah 3:15, "Then I will give you shepherds after my own heart, who will lead you with knowledge and understanding."

We encourage each of our district pastors and local leaders to pray this verse daily. We also would like to encourage our district family to set a reoccurring alarm at 3:15 pm each day to pray for wisdom and guidance.

As a part of our prayer strategy, a suggested monthly prayer will be sent out from the DAC's Prayer & Communication Committee at the beginning of each month, starting in December, until District Assembly in June 2025.

Monthly prayer focuses: Dec: District Profile & DS Profile development; Jan: Potential candidates; Feb: DAC as they narrow the list to 10; Mar: Board of General Superintendents (BGS) & DAC as they narrow list to 2-3 to interview; Apr: Candidate interviews; May: Dr. Mike & Mary Palmer as they transition into a new season of ministry; June: Assembly and new DS.

TIMELINE

- 11.22.24: District Survey & Assessment <u>link</u> goes live.
- 12.2.24 12.12.24: District Zone Zoom Conversations.
- 12.15.24: District Survey & Assessment link closes.
- 1.8.25: District Profile finalized & sent out with nomination link.
- 1.21.25: Deadline for all nominations.
- 2.19.25: Biographical information for all nominations completed.
- **2.20.25**: Biographical information document sent to DAC along with straw ballot to register first 5 choices.
- 2.27.25: DAC meeting to discern list of 10 candidates and finalize compensation package.
- 3.15.25: List of 10 candidates sent to BGS for approval.
- **3.21.25:** RD sends approved list to DAC with survey to take straw ballot of top three candidates.
- 3.25.25: DAC meeting to prioritize remaining candidate list and discern 2-3 with whom to invite to conversations.
- **4.2.25**: RD or JGS to set up dates for conversations with nominees; DAC determine questions for conversations.
- 4.19.25: RD sends questions to candidates.
- **4.21.25 4.22.25:** Candidates interview with DAC.
- **4.22.25**: DAC meets to finalize moving approach and appoint transition point person.
- **4.23.25 6.1.25:** Process committee completes process and candidate presentation for District Assembly.
- **6.1.25 6.2.25:** District Assembly farewell to current DS, election/welcome of new DS 30 days following Assembly.
